Website & Social Media Users

- Contact form submissions
- Email addresses
- Analytics data (IP address, device type, browsing behaviour)
- Social media interactions

We only collect the minimum data necessary to provide our services.

3. How we collect your data

We collect data through:

- Direct communication (email, phone, forms)
- Compliance inspections and assessments
- Social media interactions
- Website forms (once launched)
- Documentation provided by landlords, tenants or contractors

4. How we use your personal data

We use your data to:

- Provide compliance and safety services
- Produce reports, certificates and documentation
- Manage bookings and communication
- Maintain legal and regulatory records
- Improve our services and digital platforms
- Respond to enquiries and customer support requests

We do **not** use your data for automated decision-making or profiling.

5. Lawful basis for processing

We process personal data under the following lawful bases:

- **Contract** – to deliver compliance services you have requested
- **Legal obligation** – to meet regulatory and safety requirements
- **Legitimate interests** – to manage our business operations
- **Consent** – for marketing communications (you may withdraw at any time)

6. Data sharing

We may share your data with:

- Accredited assessors
- Certification bodies
- Subcontractors working under confidentiality agreements
- Legal authorities where required
- IT and cloud service providers

We **never** sell personal data.

7. Data storage & security

We protect your data using:

- Encrypted digital storage
- Password-protected systems
- Secure cloud platforms
- Identity & access control policies
- Staff training in security and confidentiality

Only authorised personnel can access your data.

8. Data retention

We keep personal data only for as long as necessary to:

- Deliver our services
- Meet legal and regulatory requirements
- Maintain accurate business records

Retention periods are reviewed annually.
